# HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

Working safely doesn't just mean looking out for yourself. It also means looking out for your co-workers. When each person demonstrates team safety awareness, the workplace is safer for all of us. Taking a moment to recognize hazards **as a team** is an important part of keeping you and your co-workers safe and is an essential part of doing a quality FLRA / LMRA / JHA.

- Has everyone on your team participated in the completion of your FLRA?
- Does everyone on your team have the proper PPE for the job, and is it being worn correctly?
- What could go wrong and could someone get hurt if it goes wrong?
- Does everyone have the right tools for the task?
- Are you ensuring that everything is being done "The Safest Way"?

Communicate with your co-workers and other trades working around you. Tell them about potential hazards; if you see something, say something.

## LEADER'S QUESTION TO WORKERS:

What eye hazards could your task generate?
