WEEKLY HEALTH CHECK

Throughout turnaround we have had a number of injuries result from poor body positioning and wrong PPE for the job during hand tool use.

As we de-blind remember the following when using impact guns:

- Wear required PPE: Face shield and double hearing are required when using impact guns. Also ensure long hair is tucked into coveralls and that all other basic PPE is being worn and in good condition.
- Ensure that your hands are out of the line of fire, and that your body is positioned in such a way that you will not be injured during your task.
- Inspect the impact gun, any accessories and airlines for any signs of damage. If damaged, tag it out of service and replace it with one that is safe for use.
- Unplug the impact gun when not in use or when changing accessories.

Take a moment to identify the potential hazards of the tools you are using, choose to work safe.
