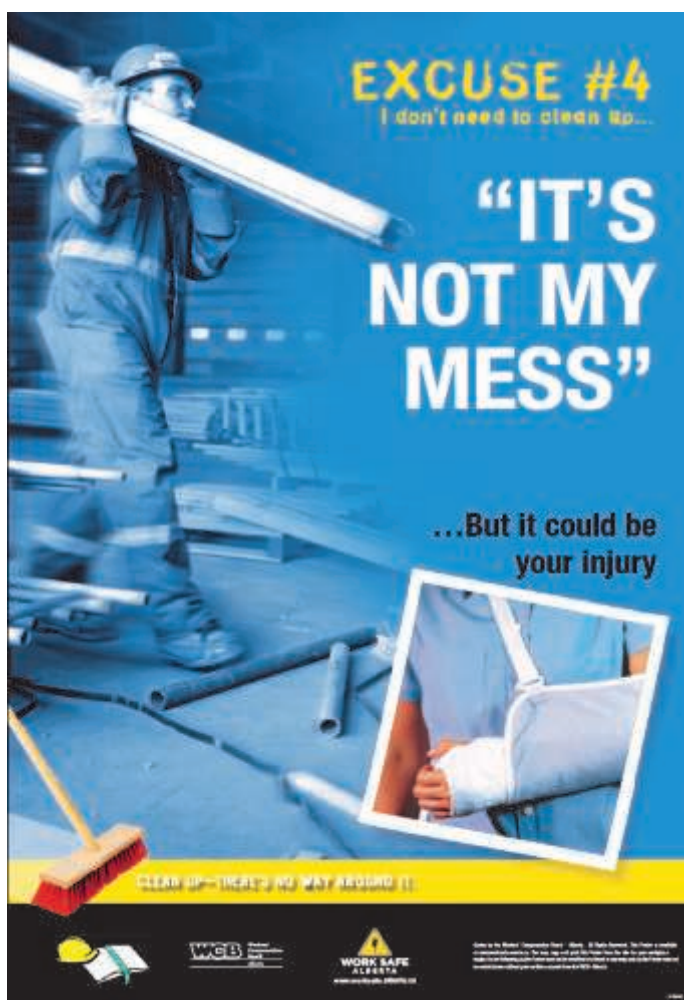
OLYMPUS WEEKLY HEALTH CHECK

As we start week 3 of Olympus we want to stress how crucial it is that we refocus, reduce our tolerance for risk and make our health and safety our first priority.

During week 3 of our 2014 Turnaround, Ursa Major, we had 7 First Aid injuries and 3 Medical Treatments. That's 10 people hurt in 1 week! 50% of these were hand related injuries. All injuries resulted from tasks we all do every day, walking, using hand tools, ascending/descending stairs, and opening & closing doors.

We must learn from the past, give our full attention to the task we are performing, and stop taking risks. **There is no acceptable excuse for not working safely!**

Incident Date	Division	Company	Severity	Body Part	Incident Description
Mar 29	Hydro Processing	Syncrude	FA	Head	Employee's wrench slipped bumping their safety glasses causing a cut to their nose.
Mar 30	Utilities & Offsites	Norcan	NC	Knee	Worker was descending a step ladder and hooked their foot under a support angle beam and over rotated twisting their knee.
Mar 31	Conversion	Jacobs	MT	Fingers	When repositioning a airline manifold a workers hand was pinched between the fitting and a scaffolding tube.
Apr 1	Utilities & Offsites	Ceda	FA	Eyes	Wind blew unknown debris into a workers eye.
Apr 3	Conversion	Jacobs		Exposure	Worker came in close proximity to a vent and was potentially exposed to unknown fumes/gas
Apr 4	Conversion	Ceda		Hands	Worker jammed their hand between the tool they were using and a valve stem handle.
