DAILY FOCUS BACK TO THE BASICS

Sometimes, depending on the work in progress, the basics of health and safety are forgotten. It is essential to remind everyone at work that they have a responsibility to themselves and others to always do their task "The Safest Way".

If most of our focus is on the details of specific tasks and work practices, we can easily forget to step back and remember the "big picture". Fundamentally, this means developing an all-around "safety" attitude and always treating safety as a core value.

Safety Basics Include:

- Wearing all required basic and specialty PPE, button the button above the zipper of your coveralls, wear your hard hat, gloves and wristlets, and protect your eyes.
- Use handrails when ascending/descending stairs.
- Keep your work area clean of debris and materials.
- Properly store hand tools when not in use, even if they will be used again momentarily.
- Practice safe walking, use cross walks and ensure traffic is stopped before crossing the street.

Simply by paying attention to hazards and engaging our brains before we act in a potentially unsafe manner, we can prevent incidents. Last minute risk assessments need to be done to ensure everyone "Stops & Thinks" and gets "Back to the Basics".

KEY LEARNINGS

Yesterday a worker completing a task on 8-3 Coker got their hand caught between a pipe spool and a column. This is our second line of fire injury in as many weeks

Did You Know

Did you know that "hand injuries" alone account for one third of the millions of disabling on-the-job incidents occurring each year? Most of these hand injuries are caused by pinch points 80 % of them in fact.
