DAILY FOCUS TAKE YOUR FAMILY TO WORK

If your work could scratch them, cut them, burn them, sever a finger, arm or leg – if your work could kill them – would you intervene? Would you change the way you work? Complete your various tasks as if the people you work with were your child, grandchild, wife, brother, sister or husband.

Worker was using a snipe wrench on a flange when the nut broke free. The force the worker was applying caused the worker to lose their balance and grab for a scaffolding tube to stable themselves causing injury to their shoulder.

If you were watching your father execute this task, would you have stopped him?

While using a 1' impact with 1-1/4 swivel socket & standing upright grasping socket collar with left hand at approximately shoulder height, employee situated impact near 3 o'clock position on flange and activated tool. During rotation, the plastic retainer ring from base connection failed and unraveled causing a loss of control when socket contacted employee's left gloved hand resulting in approx. 1/2" abrasion to tip of thumb.

If this was your brother, would you have suggested a safer way?

While working on the 13 deck of the Coker a worker placed pin bar on the fire blanket and it slipped out of his hand and went through a hole in the fire blanket. The pry bar fell to deck 4 approximately 120 feet, and landed on the roof of the building.

If your wife were working below, would you have taken the time to ensure nothing would fall?

Employee was attempting to reposition an airline manifold. A co-worker that was walking by attempted to assist in the repositioning of the manifold. The worker had his hand on the fitting and was in close proximity of a scaffold tube. When the workers moved the manifold the injured employees hand was pinched between the fitting and the scaffold tube.

If you're your son or daughter were helping you with this lift, would you have taken the time to ensure she wouldn't get hurt?

Family matters – so should the person working next to you.
