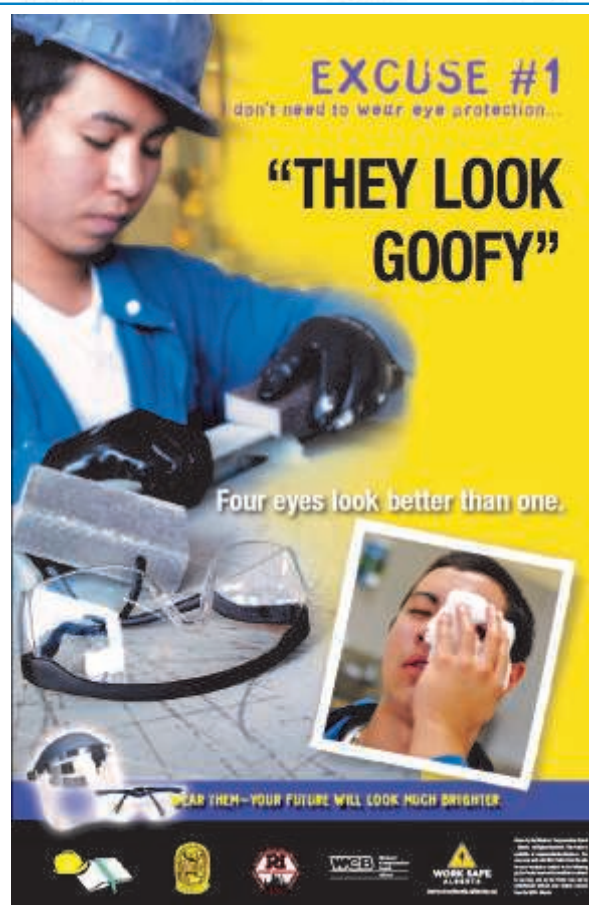
## OLYMPUS WEEKLY HEALTH CHECK

In the past week we have had 7 FA and 1 MT, that's 8 injuries in 7 days.

We are trending towards a serious incident. Objects are being dropped, people are being hurt and our incident count is already significantly higher than it was during 2014 Event. If we continue to do our tasks without always thinking what could go wrong, ... if we don't make sure it is the safest way....you or your partner could be hurt .

Do what needs to be done to prepare and execute your task the SAFEST way, not the fastest way!

### OLYMPUS INJURY SUMMARY APRIL 5—12 2015

Incident Date	Division	Company	Severity	Body Part	Incident Description
Apr 7	Conversion	Jacobs	FA	Eye	Employee felt irritation in right eye while walking from the change room to lunch room
Apr 8	Hydroprocessing	Ed Ex	FA	Back	Worker reported pain/stiffness in lower left back.
Apr 7	Conversion	Jacobs	FA	Head	Worker was struck in face shield with hammer wrench.
Apr 9	Conversion	HCBI	FA	Hand	Worker got hand caught in between pipe spool and column on level 12 of 8-3 coker unit.
Apr 8	U&O	Jacobs	FA	Eye	Employee was looking down when a pile of debris and/or dust came up from the ground into his face.
Apr 10	Conversion	Jacobs	MT	Shoulder	Employees was using a snipe wrench on a flange. When the nut broke free the force that employee was using caused the worker to lose their balance and grab for a scaffolding tube resulting in an injury to their shoulder.
Apr 10	Hydroprocessing	Ed Ex	FA	Hand	During rotation, the plastic retainer ring from base connection failed and unraveled causing a loss of control when socket contacted employee's left gloved hand resulting in approx. 1/2" abrasion to tip of thumb.
Apr 12	U&O	Aluma	FA	Shoulder	Worker struck on shoulder by a piece of refractory that fell.
