ON SITE LIGHT VEHICLE USE

The following guidelines are set forth by Syncrude for the operation of light vehicles. Following these regulations will help ensure that you and those around you will make it home safe.

- Operators of light vehicles will follow all posted speed limits and traffic signs.
- Drivers must indicate backing up by sounding the horn twice. When in a congested area
- Drivers must perform a pre-use vehicle inspection to ensure they are safe to operate.
- Headlights and taillights must be on at all times.
- Use a seatbelts are compulsory for all occupants.
- Vehicles must be turned off when not in use—exception for warming up vehicles during extreme cold temperatures (max 15 minutes) An exception is made for vehicles being used as a warm up facility while performing outdoor work.
- The wearing of a hood is not permitted while operating a vehicle.

DID YOU KNOW?

During Turnaround at Syncrude when completing any task that may generate flying particles/debris : Metal to metal contact, grinding, impacting or wood working with power tools, the use of sealed eyewear in combination with a full face shield is mandatory. When the use of a APR is required the user will revert to a full-face APR.

KEY LEARNINGS

Over the last 12 month there have been two incidents involving Magnetic Drills resulting in recordable injuries.

FINDINGS:

- Improper job setup—Leadership did not ensure that hazards, risk controls specific to the work were discussed
- Failure to identify Hazard or Risk—Workers did not recognize the risk of placing their hand in the line of fire.

WORKER SAFETY TAKE AWAYS:

- Always access your work area prior to completing task
- Always be aware of body positioning
- Use tools according to manufactures guidelines
