HAZARD IDENTIFICATION & MITIGATION

A hazard is any circumstance or condition which poses the risk of an unplanned and unwanted event, with a potential for harm in terms of human injury or ill health, damage to property, the workplace environment or a combination of these.

Hazard Identification is the process of recognizing that a hazard exists and defining its characteristics.

Hazard Mitigation is any action taken to reduce or eliminate the long term risk of human injury, health, property damage or environment from the Hazards

So as you start each job, ask yourself:

1. Are there substandard conditions in the area you will be working? If so work with your supervisor to mitigate the hazards.
2. Is there a safer way to complete the task?
3. Do I have all the right tools/equipment for the job ?
4. Will I require any additional personal protective equipment?
5. Are all safe work procedures being followed?

Be aware of the potential hazards associated with your work and make your choices carefully!!

Incidents & Learning

- ◆ Hydro Processing Plant 16-1 - On Feb 25, 2015 A contract employee suffered a cut lip after tripping over a temporary scaffold stand.
⇒ Learnings: Never accept substandard conditions, if you can not mitigate the hazard, ask for help from your supervisor.
- ◆ Utilities & Offsite Plant 25-1 - On Feb 21, 2015 Contract employees were working in and around CO 4 FD Fans, when a flow valve was inadvertently hit and partially closed off.
⇒ Ensure while completing your FLRA you identify unit equipment that can inadvertently be closed or shut down by contact & seek operations assistance to mitigate or eliminate the risk.
- ◆ Feb 21, 2015 A generator being used to power temporary facilities in and around bldg 1071 suffered a mechanical failure resulting in a fire.
