## Today's Focus: Communication

Today in Utilities the importance of Communication was made very clear. During a pre-job meeting it was discovered that the emergency response plan for a personnel lift that was being made was not valid due to technical changes to equipment; and could not be completed as written. Emergency response was contacted and a new response plan was made. Discovery of this issue was a direct result of excellent communication between trades that would be working together and in close proximity to others. Failure to communicate like this could have resulted in serious personnel injury.

When you work with other people do you take the time to ask them how their work could affect yours? How your work could affect them? Do you know your permit? Do the other people working with you? Leaders, are you clear in your direction to workers? Do you assess the area into which you are sending them? Do you ensure they are aware of other work in the area? Communication is a two way process. Everyone must be engaged so that everyone is informed. The better we communicate with each other, the lower the chance that we can inadvertently injure a co-worker. You'd do it if it was your grandchild.....
