SAFETY FOCUS: MY BROTHER'S (SISTER'S) KEEPER

Interventions are a key component to preventing incidents from happening. We can look after one another by intervening every time we notice an unsafe act or a hazard. Also, be receptive of interactions from co-workers; they are only trying to protect your health and wellness. We need to become bold and not afraid to communicate the hazards. Someone's life may depend on it. One day it may even be your own.

Below are some examples of real instances on Ursa Major, where people were observed NOT looking out for each other:

- Two individuals were standing together, discussing their task, and one was not wearing a hard hat
- An individual, who was working as part of a large crew, was not wearing gloves while working
- An individual, who was working as part of a large crew, was using a grinder without a face shield. As well, one worker was wearing a face shield but his helper was not.

In each of these situations, there was opportunity for a peer to peer intervention. Had an interaction occurred, these situations could have been corrected immediately, thus eliminating the risk and hazard that is associated with each unsafe act.
