SAFETY FOCUS: MY BROTHER'S (SISTER'S) KEEPER

The workforce for Ursa Major is quickly diminishing, as various units are in pre-startup phase. It is a time to continue to be extra vigilant for those who are leaving, and for those still remaining. We need to keep looking out for one another, staying aware of conditions that can contribute to potential injuries such as:

- Distractions such as thinking about / planning the next job or task
- Rushing to complete work before the end of the shift or term of service
- Returning to work fatigued

Plan

- Time Management - Allow sufficient time to complete work / handover. This will avoid rushing at the end of the shift or day.
- Workforce Job Planning - Ensure that all workers are aware of the number of available people vs. jobs, high risk work, weather, leadership (acting/availability), plant stability, etc.

Re-Focus

- Discuss personal factors that could lead to inattention.
- Hold afternoon discussion to help workers refocus for the rest of shift.
- Hold a morning discussion to help workers refocus for the start of shift.
- Ask workers to complete an afternoon FLRA with focus on personal factors and work area / team changes.

Monitor

- Increase leader visibility in the field through leader tours, walk-about, paired observations,
- FLRA checks, etc. do at least one more than normal and be sure to do one in the afternoon.

- Unaware/ inattentive of potential hazard
