SAFETY FOCUS: AT RISK BEHAVIOURS

Why do we accept putting ourselves or others at risk to get a task done? Maybe a scaffolding tube is in an awkward location putting you in close proximity to a hot pipe, maybe you need to stretch a little further than you know you should to access something. Maybe you need to adjust your PPE but feel rushed so you don't take the time to go to a designated area to do so. It is okay to say no, I am not going to put myself at risk. Take the time you need to ensure your safety, and the safety of those around you. Talk to your foreman if you do not feel you can complete a task 100% safely and work together to take the necessary steps to mitigate the risk.

Remember, if you don't take the time to perform the task safely, you may not have the time to finish the task at all.
