The goal of completing any task safely is best achieved by working as a team. This requires being concerned not just for your safety, but the safety of all workers from all trades working around you.

Be a team player:

- Address all housekeeping issues, even if they aren't yours.
- Intervene on co-workers not working safely.
- Maintain open communication with everyone in the area about the work you are doing, identifying line of fire and other potential hazards.
