DE-BLINDING

As we work towards de-blinding the structures, we need to ensure workers remain focused on the high risk of incident or injury this process involves.

Remain focused during de-blinding:

- Ensure a quality FLRA and area inspection are completed to eliminate and control hazards prior to starting work.
- Identify potential pinch point/line of fire hazards and reassess for new hazards throughout your task
- Use the proper tool for the job and stay focused on body positioning throughout your task.
- Be aware that live commodities are being introduced into the unit and identify what potential hazard this creates in your work area.

De-blinding brings significant changes to our work environments. By being aware of the changes happening we **can** prevent injuries from occurring.
